**Notes for the Feast**

**The Feast for the Mystery of the Holy Trinity** was established to celebrate the mystery that God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit are and forever were one true God - and that this the Triune God is the God of our salvation. The festive colour is **white**, signifying purity, like the priestly robes of the righteous before His throne - or **golden**, pointing to the heavenly treasures.

For our Confession of the faith on this Sunday we shall use the *Athanasian Creed* - as you will find it as an insert in your bulletin.

### **About Holy Communion**

In the Sacrament we are made one with the risen Christ, and with each other. According to Holy Scripture, oneness in faith and confession is a precondition for such unity. As such, only Christians who share our faith and confession, and who therefore belong to congregations in the fellowship of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, will commune in our church. **Visitors wishing to receive the sacrament** - please speak with Pastor prior to the service. We ask that our guests be respectful of our faith. **We sincerely welcome our visitors**; we assure you that we uphold this practice also out of concern for *your* spiritual welfare, and that our Pastor would love to study Scripture with you and help you embrace the full counsel of God, so that we can celebrate the Sacrament in a manner pleasing to God and beneficial for us all.

**A Stewardship Thought for the Sunday:** Part of our readings for today is John 3:6 - "That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit."
