

Dear brethren,

the Sixth Commandment is: You shall not commit adultery! Viewed in light of Holy Scripture as a whole (which is how Christians view individual statements of Holy Scripture), this Commandment clearly teaches that marriage between man and woman is the only context in which it is pleasing to God that humans engage in sexual relations.

Have you not read, as our Lord Jesus says it, with regards to marriage, that He who made them at the beginning 'made them male and female.'

Matthew 19:4-6

And He did, and it is right there for all to read: God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

Genesis 1:27

Exactly with our differences as man and woman are we made in the image of God, with the capacity to bring new life into the world out of our love, as all life has come into the world, to begin with, out of the love of God.

Furthermore, man and woman living together in love was to be a reflection of how Man was to live with God Himself, in love. And the love between God and Man is love between parties not only alike, but also different. Man is not God! Accordingly, sexual relations between men, or between women, represent a distortion of what God created, and is quite contrary to His intent for His most beloved creature.

It is the denial of this fundamental difference between creature and Creator that leads to the idea that it is natural for men to have sexual relations with other men, and women with women. Holy Scripture describes this, also: They changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator. Their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature; likewise, also, men left the natural use of the woman and burned in their lust for one another, and men committed what is shameful with men.

Romans 1

Mankind has lost sight of the Creator being fundamentally different from His creature; and so, Mankind has come to seek a god that is alike to itself, and seek in its false gods, made in the image of Man, that which it finds missing in itself. Similarly, for those who feel incomplete, it will come to seem natural, also, to seek completion in sexual and romantic relations with someone alike to themselves. Idolatry is religious homosexuality - not entirely unlike how idolatry is also religious adultery.

And obviously, only to a culture having lost sight of the fundamental difference between Creator and creature can homosexuality, so clearly contrary to the natural order of things, come to seem natural; just as a so-called church can only come to view homosexuality, or any other departure from both the created order of God and His clear command, given in Holy Scripture, when it confuses creature and Creator and so comes to see the human self as not only the ultimate judge of good and evil, absolutely autonomous from the authority of God, but also as the creator of his own self, and his own reality.
