

Dear brethren,

the Sixth Commandment is: You shall not commit adultery! As the Ten Commandments altogether sum up how it is God's will that His most beloved creatures should live in His love, this Commandment is also a summary of what Holy Scripture teaches about marriage, sex and sexuality.

Another summary, of course, is what our Lord Jesus replied when asked about marriage: Have you not read that He who made them at the beginning 'made them male and female,' and said: 'For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'?

Matthew 19:4-5

Among the supposedly educated, but obviously either ignorant or dishonest, enemies of the Church of Christ, it has become fashionable in recent years not only to pretend that these words are not in Holy Scripture, and claim that our Lord Jesus has said nothing about homosexual marriage, but also to claim that Leviticus is the only book in Holy Scripture to address homosexual acts. As we have already seen, this is not true; our Lord Jesus has stated clearly what marriage is, and what is God's will with regards to sex.

The dishonesty of the claim that homosexual acts are addressed only in Leviticus (obviously, ignorance becomes dishonesty when the ignorant claims knowledge!) becomes even more obvious, though, when one actually bothers to look; as unbelievers usually claim to have, also falsely, when they say that Holy Scripture is silent about homosexual acts, except for Leviticus.

In his Letter to the Romans, the holy Apostle Paul condemns homosexual acts as unnatural (that is: in conflict with the created order of God) and shameful (that is: abominable to God), and describes how the very desire to engage in them arise to begin with as a result of Mankind's estrangement from God.

Romans 1:18-27

Furthermore, the Apostle lists men who engage in homosexual acts among those who will not inherit the Kingdom of God; interestingly, he adds that such were some of you, but you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.

I Corinthians 6:10-11

Embracing the faith involves giving up ungodly living; but on the other hand, those living in sin are not excluded from the salvation of God, nor from His Church, when they embrace it, and repent. No one familiar with the faith will be surprised at this! It is common, though, among the enemies of the Church of Christ to refer to being Christian as "hating homosexuals"; just as it is not uncommon among the supposedly educated enemies of the faith to claim that all that Christians seek in the faith to begin with is an excuse for "hating homosexuals"!

The Apostle also sets men who engage in homosexual acts in contrast to a righteous person and list such acts among things contrary to sound doctrine.

I Timothy 1:10-11

But then, should one be surprised to find unbelievers to also be untruthful?
